### Runways

---

1. 9R – 27L is 3,225 feet long
  2. 9L – 27L is 3,241 feet long
  3. 18R – 36L is 3,350 feet long
  4. 18R – 36R is 3,260 feet long
- Two of the runways are lighted for 24-hour operation

### Acreage

---

511 acres

### Hangars

---

164 T-Hangars for aircraft storage

### Aircraft

---

Over 300 based at the airport  
Limited to a maximum take-off weight of 12,500 pounds

### Aircraft Operations

---

About 175,000 take-offs and landings in 2009 with over 50% of these operations consisting of flight training activities from five flight schools

### Air Traffic Control Tower

---

Hours of operation from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.

### Operators

---

Five flight schools, two banner towers, several news helicopters, and two fixed based operators with both offering self-service fueling

### Recognition

---

2008 General Aviation Airport of the Year by the Florida Department of Transportation

### Licensed

---

Through the State of Florida Department of Transportation

### Economic Impact

---

FDOT estimated economic impact of \$133 million on the community

### History

---

1956 Broward County acquired the airport from the U.S. Navy
