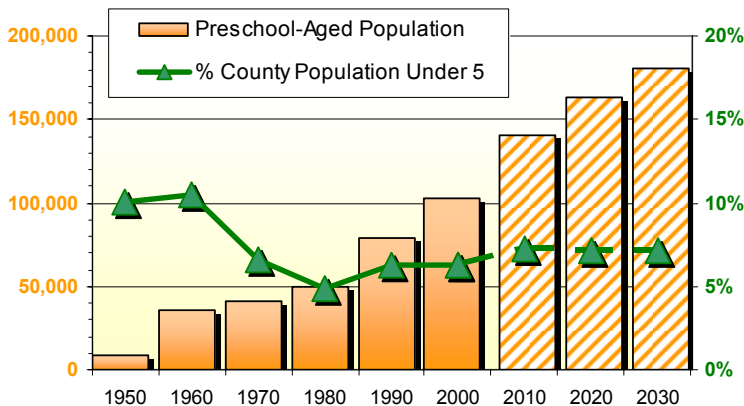

## Broward's Youngest Residents: The Preschool Population

*More than 100,000 children under age five live in Broward County. Almost 16,000 of these preschool children live in families whose income is below the federal poverty level.*

### Population Characteristics.

With annual births in excess of 20,000 per year, Broward County has more than 100,000 residents under age five. These preschool children make up 6% of the population.



However, in the 1980s the preschool population grew significantly as more young families moved to Broward and “baby boomers” gave birth to the so called “baby boomlet”. In the 1990s, preschool population growth stabilized, reflecting the declining fertility rates of aging “baby boomers”. Young families continue to migrate into Broward keeping preschool population growth in line with growth of the population as a whole.

Projections from the Broward County Population Forecasting Model<sup>1</sup> show that the preschool population will continue to grow at about 0.7% per year over the next thirty years, resulting in a population of approximately 181,000 under age five by 2030.

### Families with Preschool Children

In 2000, 84,157 families had one or more children under five. These families had an average of 1.2 preschool children per family. The majority of preschool children lived with both parents in a married couple family.

Population growth in this cohort reflects broader demographic changes taking place in the County. During the 1960s and 1970s, the preschool population grew at a much lower rate than the county population as a whole, because most of the county’s growth was due to in-migration of retirees.
